General knowledge of Dhvani or Sound and Naad or Music

Whatever we hear with our ears is called sound. Music is only related to the melodious sounds that we like to hear. The melodious sound of music is called Naad. Sound originates from vibrations. When we play any musical instrument, there is a vibration in it which is called Andolan or movements. A sound produced which is fixed with regular and steady vibration in its numbers is called Naad. In other words, the sweet sound useful in music is called Naad.

The sound produced slowly is called small or Chota Naad and the sound produced louder is called big or Bada Naad. Chotta Naad is heard for a shorter distance and bada Naad sound is heard for a longer distance.

Naad ki Uchayi - Nichai - While singing, we feel that the tone is high or low, as if the sound is higher than the vowel. The number of movements or vibration per second in a high pitch is increased.

Naad ki jaati and Guna – The tone and sound of each instrument is different from other and this is called naad ki jati or guna.
